I. Policy Work

Offer state-wide interfaith advocacy for implementing Paris Climate Agreement and transformative climate justice policies

Cooperate with allied organizations to advance the Paris Climate Agreement of reducing carbon emissions by half by 2030 and related climate policies.

Offer local interfaith advocacy for caring for the Earth and all life.

Create interfaith opportunities to partner with the lower income community within its region to connect creation care and climate justice with social justice and environmental concerns. Create interfaith opportunities to advance the Paris Climate Agreement of reducing carbon emissions by half by 2030 and related climate policies within their local communities.

Increase understanding of placing a price on carbon.

The Steering Committee will apply a voluntary carbon tithe to account for the TIPL 2017 state carbon emissions. Local chapters will be aware and accountable for their carbon emissions.

II. Chapter Engagement of Faith Group Partners and Members

Offer interfaith events: Chapters will arrange for at least two interfaith events, which engage TIPL faith partners and members and welcomes the community to participate in a spiritual response to climate change.

Chapter outreach and recruitment of new faith group partners. Chapters will recruit new faith group partners with a focus on increased diversity.

Communication with partners and members.

Members and partners will receive a monthly TIPL e-newsletter. We will also maintain our website, Facebook page, and publish an annual TIPL brochure. Chapters will engage each of its faith group partners annually.
